Designer Guidelines

Here are the guidelines the garments must follow in order to participate in the 14th Annual Recycled Fashion Show 2019: Artists Restyled

Garments are required to be

- **75% recycled or reused materials.** The recycled materials used in your garment must have been collected and used once before, no store bought items should be used as “recycled” material (i.e.: garbage bags or duct tape)
- **Floor length and Couture-style.** Both Male and Female garments are acceptable as long as the garment is a “high fashion” garment. (think Prom not Halloween)
- Turned in: **FRIDAY, November 1, 2019 by 6:00pm to Ms. Sue.** Garments turned in after the final due date may not be allowed to participate in the Fashion Show. If need an extension contact Ms. Sue before the deadline.
- A **representation of a famous artist’s style** and an **environmental issue.** Artists, material and environmental issues are chosen by the designer(s). Addressing a particular environmental issue in the design of your garment is as important as the design itself. Garments should raise awareness about the particular issue, and the artist represented (i.e.: Climate change is affecting butterflies so my garment is inspired by Damion Hurst who uses butterflies in his artwork and I am using plastic bags)
Environmental Issues must be approved by Ms. Sue before you begin work on your garment.
- Original and unduplicated so please **let Ms. Sue know as soon as you have chosen the artist and material** you would like to work with. Artists and material assignments will be on a first come-first serve basis.

Final evaluation of garments will take place at the dress rehearsal on

Friday, Nov 8, 2019

Designers/Models:

- All designers and models are **required to fill out an application, photo release and agree to the guidelines** of the 14th Annual Recycled Fashion Show.
- Designers **may choose their own model** or have one assigned to them.
- Designers must get their concept, mood board and sketch **approved before beginning work on their garments**. Please see Ms. Sue for approval.
- Designers may work individually or in teams of 2 or 3.
- **Designers will be responsible to meet all deadlines**. Missing deadlines may result in garments being pulled from the Fashion Show.
- **Designers must attend all of the Fashion Show events, including “Make It Work”, Dress Rehearsal and Fashion Show in order to participate**. For a list of events, see the reverse of this document.
- **Designers must have at least 4 in person “touch base” meetings** with Ms. Sue in order to participate in the Fashion Show.
- Designers should keep in **good communication with YAA Staff**. Designers that do not return phone calls or reply to emails may not be allowed to participate in the show.
- Designers and models are **eligible to earn Community Service Hours** for their time participating in the Recycled Fashion Show. Please see Ms. Sue or Ms. Delany, Volunteer coordinator to get hours signed or letters issued. Ms. Sue will only sign hours dealing directly with the Fashion Show.
- **This is a judged completion. There will be an interview portion** with the designers the night of the Fashion Show to speak about your work. Please arrive on time, dress professionally and conduct yourselves in a professional manner representative of YAA.
- **The 1st, 2nd and 3rd place winners may be displayed at YAA in an exhibit through December**. Winners must agree to display their garments through 12/31/19.
- YAA reserves the right to pull any garment from the Fashion Show.
