ARTREACH — a free after school art and academic enrichment program for homeless youth.

PARENT TO KID CONNECTION — Free monthly workshops with complimentary food and childcare for families! Each session explores a unique blend of creative play, art-making, and open dialogue, facilitated by parenting experts and professional artists.

GIRLS EMPOWERED — an arts-based gender empowerment program conducted at PACE Center Broward for at-risk teen girls.

YAA for ALL (Access to Lifelong Learning) — Working in partnership with the University of Miami – Nova Southeastern University's Center for Autism and Related Disabilities (CARD), YAA has developed special programs and events for children and adults with autism or other sensory integration sensitivities.

YAA at Home — providing free online educational art activities and videos for all to access anywhere and anytime.

YAA On-The-Go — A new mini bus program that increases the number of homeless children served as well as providing access to art-based programs for children and families at schools and community events in Broward's low-income neighborhoods.
