

Young At Art (YAA) Museum SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES ARTrageous Summer Camps



Scholarship Requirements.

- Household should receive Florida SNAP, Florida TANF, or FCPIR.
- Ability to accompany the drop off and pick up of children to YAA on time.
- Have ability to drop off and pick up daily from 9am-5pm.
- Be available for child to attend the full camp week of camp all 5 days.
- 1. Families interested in scholarships should email the following:
 - A letter of request from the parent/ guardian explaining circumstances and reasons for wanting child to attend YAA camp. Specifically include, how having this scholarship will make a difference for the family and the child. Include full name of parent and child, child's age, mailing address, home phone number, cell phone number and email address.
 - Current eligibility letter from Florida SNAP, Florida TANF, or FCPIR.
 - A scanned art sample from the student.
 - Also request their first, second and third choice for camp weeks.

- 2. Approved families will be contacted by email by Museum Staff. Scholarships are for one full week of Art Exploration Summer Camp (YAA's Specialty, Digital, and Video Game Design Camps are not eligible under the scholarship program).
- 3. Once approved families must comply with the following obligations.
 - Fill out paper work and follow all guidelines, policies and rules for YAA and camp.
 - Students must attend the entire week of summer camp
 - Students who are absent or perpetually tardy will forfeit their scholarship.
- 4. While child attends YAA camp on scholarship, families must comply with the following obligations:
 - Student hand write a short daily journal about their class/camp experience.
 - Student hand write a thank you letter to the donor by 3rd or 4th day of camp.
 - Student will provide Gold Coast Watercolor Society with an 11x14 art piece created at camp that will be displayed in the Gold Coast Watercolor Society's 50th anniversary art show.
 - Parent/Guardian write a thank you letter to the donor 3rd or 4th day of camp.
 - Student/Family create a short 30 second video testimonial of their experience in camp showing their favorite artwork by 4th day of camp.
 - Photo documentation of the art making process and samples of final works of art.
 - Agree to meet with the donor if requested.
